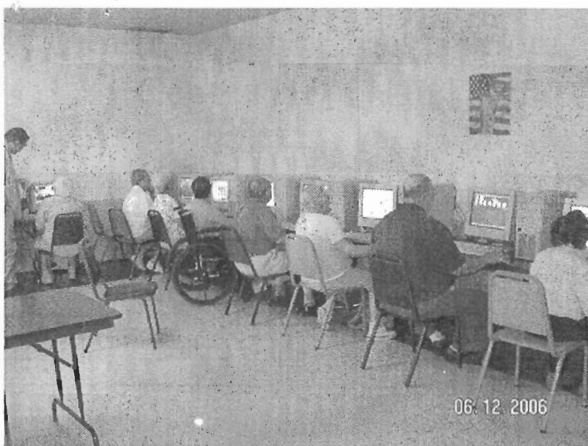
The Quad-City Community Development Corporation (QCCDC) was established in 1999 when there was a possibility the Twin City Senior Center would have to close its doors.
